Schedule Your Procedure




PAS checks your Insurance Benefits and Calls you to discuss your Benefits & Payment Options for your copay or deductible, If Any.



1 to 2 Weeks after your procedure, the EOBs start to arrive.




Procedure Performed by GANV Physician




Explanation Of Benefits (EOB)

This is **NOT** a Bill. It's a statement from your health plan that gives you an overview of the costs associated with your service or treatment, from the doctor's charge to the amount paid by your plan, to the amount you may owe.


Don't Panic, you may receive up to **5 EOBs** from your health plan. This is **NOT** a Bill or list of Future Bills.




You will receive **1 EOB** from your health plan for the Facility (Hospital or Surgical Center) where the procedure was performed.




The Pathologist diagnoses disease based on laboratory analysis of bodily tissue & fluids. You will receive **1 EOB** from your health plan for the Pathologist.



The Anesthesia Team consists of the Anesthesiologist and CRNA. You will receive **2 EOBs** from your health plan for the Anesthesia Team.



You will receive **1 EOB** from your health plan for the GANV Physician.



1 to 2 weeks after receiving your EOBs from your health plan, and depending on your insurance coverage, you will receive statements from the 4 previous medical entities. Submit any remaining balance, if necessary.
